In accordance with SB 705 all vineyard removal burning in the San Joaquin Valley will be phased out according to the following schedule. New restrictions begin January 1 of each year. Be aware of the applicable prohibition dates for your operation and plan ahead. <u>The District cannot guarantee that allocation will be available leading up to the prohibition dates</u> . Removals will not be allowed to burn after the applicable prohibition date, even if they have been inspected and placed on the waiting list.
