LA PALOMA has requested a regular variance from the applicable requirements of District Rules 1080, 2070, 2201, 2520, 4001 and 4703, in addition to the applicable conditions of the subject permits. The requested variance period will be from April 12, 2023, through August 12, 2023. If granted, the variance will allow LA PALOMA to postpone performance testing of CTU1 until they are dispatched by CAISO for a sufficient time to complete the testing.

Petitioner, Terry Benson, shared that bad weather has taken a toll on operations but LA PALOMA has a RATA test scheduled for August to ensure the facility is meeting requirements.

CHEVRON has requested a short variance from the applicable requirements of District Rules 2010, 2070, 2201, 2520, 4401, and 4623, in addition to applicable conditions of the subject permits. The requested variance period would be for a

non-consecutive 24 hour period to occur sometime between May 1, 2023, and July 1, 2023, inclusive. If granted, the variance would allow CHEVRON to continue to store VOC containing liquids in the subject tanks without an operating or functional VRS while PG&E conducts the proposed work.

Dr. Na asked if this is the only facility that will be impacted by power outage due to PG&E maintenance and the petitioner was unsure.
