

# Get up to \$60,000/year for Alternatives to Open Agricultural Burning



The California Air Resources Board has directed a phase out of agricultural burning in the San Joaquin Valley. To assist farmers in achieving this goal, the Valley Air District's Alternative to Open Agricultural Burning Incentive Program provides up to \$600 per acre for a maximum of \$60,000 per year, to chip or shred agricultural material and apply it back onto the land or into the soil.

- ▶ Chipping with soil incorporation \$600/acre
- ▶ Chipping without soil incorporation \$300/acre
- ▶ Max incentive \$60,000/year

**The program is open to chipping a wide range of orchard crops and vineyards.**
