Air Curtain Burn Box Approved Agricultural Materials

JANUARY 28, 2019 RULE 228

An Air Curtain Burn Box is an open-top combustion device with vertical, refractory lined walls that operates by forcefully projecting a fan driven pane of high velocity air over the top of the combustion chamber in such a manner as to maintain a curtain of air over the surface and a recirculating motion of air under the curtain.

Only agricultural materials on this list, forest management materials, or hazard reduction materials may be burned in an air curtain burn box.

Agricultural Material	Description					
Orchard Removals	Includes leaves, branches, trunks, roots, stumps, and untreated branch support sticks.					
Vineyard Removals	Includes vines, canes, trunks, roots, untreated grape stakes, wires, as well similar materials from kiwi vineyards.					
Orchard Attrition	Includes suckers, dead or broken branches, dead trees (trees lost due to natural causes such as wind, not to be confused with orchard removals or trees that perish from lack of watering).					
Grape Attrition	Includes suckers, dead or broken stumps, and trunks.					
Untreated Grape Stakes						
Paper Raisin Trays						
Diseased Materials	The county agricultural commissioner must determine that burning is the only means available for disposing of the diseased materials.
