



# Don't Be Left in the Dust!

## Your construction project may need a dust-control plan.

Valley Air District dust-control rules apply to construction, demolition, excavation and many other earthmoving activities.

You may be required to attend a dust-control training class and submit a dust-control plan before your project begins. Failure to do so could result in fines and project delays.

Dust is a major cause of particulate-matter air pollution in the San Joaquin Valley. Air District Rule 8021 is designed to control particle pollution by limiting dust emissions.
