NOTICE OF TRAINING COURSE FOR CERTIFICATION OF AIR PERMITTING PROFESSIONALS (CAPP)

The San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District (District) will be conducting a two-day training course for new CAPP candidates. The CAPP course is designed to review District permitting programs, policies and procedures for experienced environmental permitting professionals. Prior air permitting experience is required for acceptance as a CAPP candidate as detailed in District <u>Rule 1170</u>, <u>Section 4.0</u>.

The CAPP two-day course will be held as follows:

June 25 & 26, 2024 (Tuesday and Wednesday)
Courses are scheduled from 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM on both days.
The course will be held virtually using ZOOM. The course will not be in-person.

To become CAPP certified, candidates must attend the 2-day online class and pass a four-hour <u>online</u> exam that will be given on Tuesday July 30, 2024 at 8:30 AM. This is the only day the exam will be offered.

CAPP program candidates must send a complete CAPP training application form and the training and certification fee of \$450 to the District by June 7, 2024. Only the two-day mandatory CAPP course will be offered. The two-day optional training course will not be held at this time. Based on the required qualification criteria listed in Rule 1170, the District will review all applications and notify all candidates of their eligibility to attend this training course. Additionally, auditing the course as defined in Rule 1170 will be possible.
