

## FIREPLACE DECOMMISSIONING FORM

This form must be completed and signed when decommissioning a wood-burning fireplace and is also required for new electric heat pump applications. "Decommissioning", for the purpose of this Program, means permanently rendering inoperable.

TYPE OF WORK TO BE PERFORMED

### Freestanding Wood/Pellet Stove

- I will have my freestanding wood/pellet stove removed and delivered to a licensed dismantling/recycling facility. A dated receipt from the dismantling/recycling facility must be obtained as proof of destruction and the facility must sign the Destruction Verification section of the Claim for Payment Form. In addition, I will remove all piping associated with the freestanding stove and permanently seal off the ceiling opening.

 *Photo requirement: Must include photo of the ceiling after it has been permanently sealed off. Must include a photo taken from floor to ceiling of the room after the freestanding stove is removed. Additional photos documenting the process are encouraged.*


### Wood/Pellet Insert

*(This option requires an additional selection from either the Wood-burning firebox or Open-hearth fireplace section)*

- I will have my wood/pellet insert removed and delivered to a licensed dismantling/recycling facility. A dated receipt from the dismantling/recycling facility must be obtained as proof of destruction and the facility must sign the Destruction Verification section of the Claim for Payment Form.


### Wood-burning firebox

- I will have my wood-burning firebox and all piping associated with the wood-burning firebox removed and delivered to a licensed dismantling/recycling facility. A dated receipt from the dismantling/recycling facility must be obtained as proof of destruction and the facility must sign the Destruction Verification section of the Claim for Payment Form.


 *Photo requirement: Must show the fireplace after the wood-burning firebox and all piping associated with the firebox is removed. Must include a photo after the opening is permanently sealed off with drywall. Additional photos documenting the process are encouraged.*

### Open-hearth fireplace


- I will completely remove my chimney and wood-burning fireplace

 *Photo requirement: Must include both an interior and exterior photo after the fireplace is completely removed. Must include a photo taken from floor to ceiling of the area where the fireplace previously existed after it has been remodeled. Additional photos documenting the process are encouraged.*

- I will permanently seal up my fireplace with masonry. This option requires the interior wood-burning area of the fireplace to be completely filled in with block or bricks and cement.

 *Photo requirement: Must include a photo at the beginning of the process, the middle of the process and the end of the process when the fireplace has been permanently sealed.*

- I will permanently seal off the top of my chimney with cement. This option requires 1-2 feet of cement to seal off the top of the chimney.

 *Photo requirement: Must include a photo after the top of the chimney has been prepared but before the cement has been poured. In addition, a photo after half of the required cement has been poured and a photo after the top of the chimney has been permanently sealed off with cement. Additional photos documenting the process are encouraged.*

CERTIFICATIONS

I, the applicant, certify the following:

- *I have read all the options and understand the requirements outlined in this form. I understand that I will not be reimbursed for this project until the San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District (District) deems my wood-burning fireplace fully decommissioned.*
- *The District requires the use of a state licensed contractor when doing work related to the decommissioning of the wood-burning fireplace. The contractor must complete a Fireplace Decommissioning Contractor Certification Form (will be included with the voucher packet). I understand that I will not be reimbursed for any work performed by an unlicensed contractor.*
- *I assume all the risk and outcome of the fireplace decommissioning work completed for this project. I understand that I am responsible for obtaining all necessary permits and completing required inspections to ensure the project meets federal, state and local requirements.*
- *I understand that if I currently have a freestanding stove or fireplace insert, I am responsible for obtaining a dated receipt from a dismantling/recycling facility as proof of destruction. Freestanding stove and fireplace insert projects are not eligible for reimbursement without a dated receipt from a dismantling/recycling facility.*
- *I understand that I will need to provide photographic proof throughout the wood-burning fireplace decommissioning process, from start to finish. The photos must clearly shows all steps taken and I agree to submit these photos with the claim for payment packet.*
