- 10. The Central Region Hearing Board heard and granted the following emergency variances since the May 15, 2024, hearing:

## A. C-24-13E CRPC

On May 14, 2024, Hearing Board Chair, Daniel Hartwig, acting for and on behalf of the Central Region Hearing Board, approved an emergency variance from May 28, 2024, through June 3, 2024. The variance provided relief from specific requirements of District Rules 2070, 2201, 2520, 4623 and 4624, and allowed CRPC to continue to operate without an operational VRS.

### B. C-24-14E CertainTeed

On May 20, 2024, Hearing Board Chair, Daniel Hartwig, acting for and on behalf of the Central Region Hearing Board, approved an emergency variance from May 17, 2024, through June 15, 2024. The variance provided relief from specific requirements of District Rules 1080, 2070, 2201, 2520 and 4354, and allowed CertainTeed to continue glass manufacturing without a stack flow monitor until CERTAINTEED obtained the necessary parts to repair the monitor.

# C. C-24-15E CertainTeed

On May 22, 2024, Hearing Board Chair, Daniel Hartwig, acting for and on behalf of the Central Region Hearing Board, approved an emergency variance from May 22, 2024, through June 20, 2024. The variance provided relief from specific requirements of District Rules 1080, 2070, 2201, 2520, 4401 and 4623, and allowed CertainTeed to continue glass manufacturing without a functioning caustic flow meter.
